# Leviticus: The Way to God-Sacrifice- Chapters 1-17

Offering	Chapter	Meaning
Burnt Offering Sweet(Voluntary)	Ch. 1	Foreshadows Christ offering Himself without spot to God and pictures Christ on the cross. Heb 9:14
Meal Offering Sweet(Voluntary)	Ch. 2	Exhibits the manhood of Christ and the life offered. Heb 2:17-18
Peace Offering Sweet(Voluntary)	Ch. 3	Restored communication with God through Christ's offering. He is our peace. Eph 2:14. Thank offering Lev 7:11-12
Sin Offering Non-Sweet (Compulsory)	Ch. 4	Pictures Christ as sin bearer- made sin for us. II Cor 5:21
Trespass Offering Non-Sweet (Compulsory)	Ch. 5	Speak of sins against others and the injury sin does. Lev 5:16. Restitution taught in the words "make amends" Pictures Christ atoning for the damage of sin. II Cor 5:19; Eph 2:1

# Leviticus: The Way To God-Sacrifice- Chapters 1-17

Offering	Christ's Provision	Christ's Character
Burnt Offering Sweet(Voluntary) Lev 1:3-17; 6:8-13	Atonement	Christ's sinless nature
Meal Offering Sweet(Voluntary) Lev 2:1-16; 6:14-23	Dedication Consecration	Christ was wholly devoted to the Father's purposes
Peace Offering Sweet(Voluntary) Lev 3:1-17; 7:11-36	Reconciliation Fellowship	Christ was at peace with God
Sin Offering Non-Sweet (Compulsory) Lev 4:1-5:13; 6:24-30	Propitiation	Christ's substitutionary death
Trespass Offering Non-Sweet (Compulsory) Lev 5:14-6:7; 7:1-10	Repentance	Christ paid it all for redemption
