

Greeters Ministry: Senior Ushers

The Senior Ushers Ministry serves on the first and fourth Sundays of each month. The ministry also serves during Revival and Mid-Week Services on a rotating basis with the ministries of The Greeters Ministry. The Senior Ushers also minister for Homegoing Services held at the church and may be called to serve for

various other worship experiences at Second Nazareth.

The challenge for ushering is understanding that the ministry is to look to the needs of the worshipers. This often means not fully sharing in the worship experience as one would like for ushers must be attentive at all times.

The Senior Ushers meet on the first Sunday after worship services to address any service concerns and receive information on upcoming ministry responsibilities and/or activities.



Organized in 1903, the ministry observes its anniversary the 3rd Sunday in January of each year. This celebration is the time the ministry gives God thanks for His blessings as well as presents Him an offering via the church to further the efforts of Kingdom Building.

A founding member of the Capital City Usher Board Union that meets the second Sunday of each month at a member church, Second Nazareth hosts the Union Session in April and October and the Union Anniversary every 5 years on the 3rd Sunday in September.

The Senior Ushers also support various efforts of the other ministries of Second Nazareth and the outreach activities of Capital City.
